

The Weekender


Swap urban streets for rolling hills, quiet roads and fresh country air over the ANZAC Day long weekend.

The Ride



Starting and finishing in Leongatha, Victoria, the 185km ride is split over two days, with a 115km loop on the first day and a 70km loop on the second day.

While you'll need to prepare the legs for over 1,200m of elevation each day, Bicycle Network will be by your side the entire way, providing full on-route support, including rest stops, nutrition & hydration and medical and mechanical assistance.
